Early Childhood

At Bradley Hospital, we recognize that parenting young children can sometimes be as stressful as it is rewarding. Parents and caregivers often find it helpful to consult with a professional to answer questions and ease concerns about their rapidly developing child, or to engage in services to support their family.

Common concerns of parents and caregivers seeking our services are:

- Is my child's development progressing as it should be?
- How can I help my child to better manage his/her behavior?
- Is my child's attention and activity level appropriate for his/her age?
- How can I help my child (and family) adjust to stressful life events or family transitions?
- How can I help my child better adjust to child care or school?
- How can I help my child cope with a recent traumatic event?

The Bradley Hospital Early Childhood Outpatient Program staff has specialized training in the assessment and treatment of young children and families. We strive to help families better understand their child's development as well as plan for intervention, if necessary. We create individualized care plans for each child and family, and offer family therapy, parenting support and coaching, and individual child counseling as necessary.
