MODIFIED Contact/Droplet Isolation

The following Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is required to enter the room:

Gloves

Isolation Gown

Surgical Mask/Eye Protection







In Addition to Standard Precautions:

- Patient Source Control: Patient should don a mask when anyone enters the room if possible
- Clean Hands before entering the room, when leaving the room, and after doffing PPE
- **Don** gloves, disposable yellow gown or reusable, and mask with eye shield or surgical mask with face shield
- Remove all supplies from the room
- **Dedicate** non-critical items
- Clean and Disinfect All Equipment before it leaves the room with a Purple or bleach PDI Wipe
- Restrict Movement of Patient: Transport only if absolutely necessary
- **Restrict Visitors**

If aerosol generating procedure will be performed:

- Perform procedure in a negative pressure room. If a negative pressure room is not available, close the door.
- Don N95 mask or PAPR/CAPR along with face shield, gown and gloves during the procedure
