

# MODIFIED Contact/Droplet Isolation

The following Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is required to enter the room:

Gloves



Isolation Gown



Surgical Mask/Eye Protection



## In Addition to Standard Precautions:

- **Patient Source Control:** *Patient should don a mask when anyone enters the room if possible*
- **Clean Hands** before entering the room, when leaving the room, and after doffing PPE
- **Don** gloves, disposable yellow gown or reusable, and mask with eye shield or surgical mask with face shield
- **Remove** all supplies from the room
- **Dedicate** non-critical items
- **Clean and Disinfect All Equipment** before it leaves the room with a Purple or bleach PDI Wipe
- **Restrict Movement of Patient:** Transport only if absolutely necessary
- **Restrict Visitors**

## If aerosol generating procedure will be performed:

- Perform procedure in a negative pressure room. If a negative pressure room is not available, close the door.
- Don N95 mask or PAPR/CAPR along with face shield, gown and gloves during the procedure

Manual ventilation before intubation  
Endotracheal intubation  
Extubation

Sputum induction  
High-frequency oscillating ventilation  
Nebulized medication administration

CPR  
Bronchoscopy  
Open suctioning

High-flow oxygen  
BiPAP  
Autopsy

**DO NOT REMOVE SIGN UNTIL ROOM HAS BEEN CLEANED**

Room should be cleaned with an EPA approved product daily and at discharge

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
