- 1. The greeter/receptionist should wear a mask with eye shield for all patients approaching the reception counter (mask can be reused by cleaning hands and placing in a paper bag after use).
- 2. Patient will immediately be asked if they have respiratory symptoms and, if yes, will be provided a level 1 mask and will be asked to wear it for the entire visit.
- 3. Patient will be asked about travel history and/or exposure risk per outpatient algorithm.
- 4. If **symptom and travel/exposure history are negative**, the greeter/receptionist will remove their mask (mask can be reused by cleaning hands and placing in a paper bag after use).
- 5. If **symptom and travel/exposure history are positive** per OP algorithm (suspicious for PUI), the person who rooms the patient will escort them immediately to an exam room wearing their mask with eye shield.
- 6. The person who rooms the patient will not touch the patient and will close the exam room door.
- 7. Always Instruct patient to keep mask on for their entire visit.
- 8. The MD/DO/APP will enter the room wearing a disposable gown, gloves, and mask with eye shield.
