With the recent novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) epidemic, a new BPA will fire if the patient has any of the corresponding symptoms.


## For Clinicians

The following BPA will fire within an outpatient encounter for a patient that has reported recent international travel and has the following symptoms: cough, fever, vomiting or diarrhea.

**Note:** This BPA will only fire for providers and RNs during an outpatient encounter.
