TRULICITY

What is Trulicity?

- Trulicity is a once-weekly, injectable type 2 diabetes medication
- Along with diet and exercise, Trulicity can help lower blood glucose levels

How does it work?

- Trulicity comes in an easy to use pen that's activated with a button
- Helps control blood sugar levels that rise after eating
- It is used once a week, and controls blood sugars 24/7

Storage:

- Your Trulicity pen should be stored in the refrigerator
- If necessary, Trulicity can be stored at room temperature for up to 14 days

Disposal:

- After use, the Trulicity pen should be disposed of in a puncture resistant sharps container
- If you do not have a sharps container, try using a puncture resistant container such as an empty laundry detergent bottle, or coffee can. Refer to local regulations for how to dispose of the container properly.



How to use your Trulicity pen:

3 MAIN STEPS:


- A. Uncap the pen
- B. Place the device against your skin, and unlock
- C. Press and hold the green injection button

3 PRESS AND HOLD




STEP 1: Choose an injection site. Trulicity can be injected into the stomach, thighs, or upper arms.

STEP 2: Pull the base cap off the pen and throw it in the trash. Do not place the base cap back on the device.

STEP 3: Place the pen firmly against your skin. Unlock the device by turning the top of the pen into the unlocked position.

STEP 4: Press and hold the green injection button; you will hear loud click. Continue holding the injection button until to hear a second click. The second click means the pen has delivered the medicine.

STEP 5: Remove the pen from your skin and dispose of it in a sharps container, or another puncture resistant container. Do no throw the pen away in a household trash.
