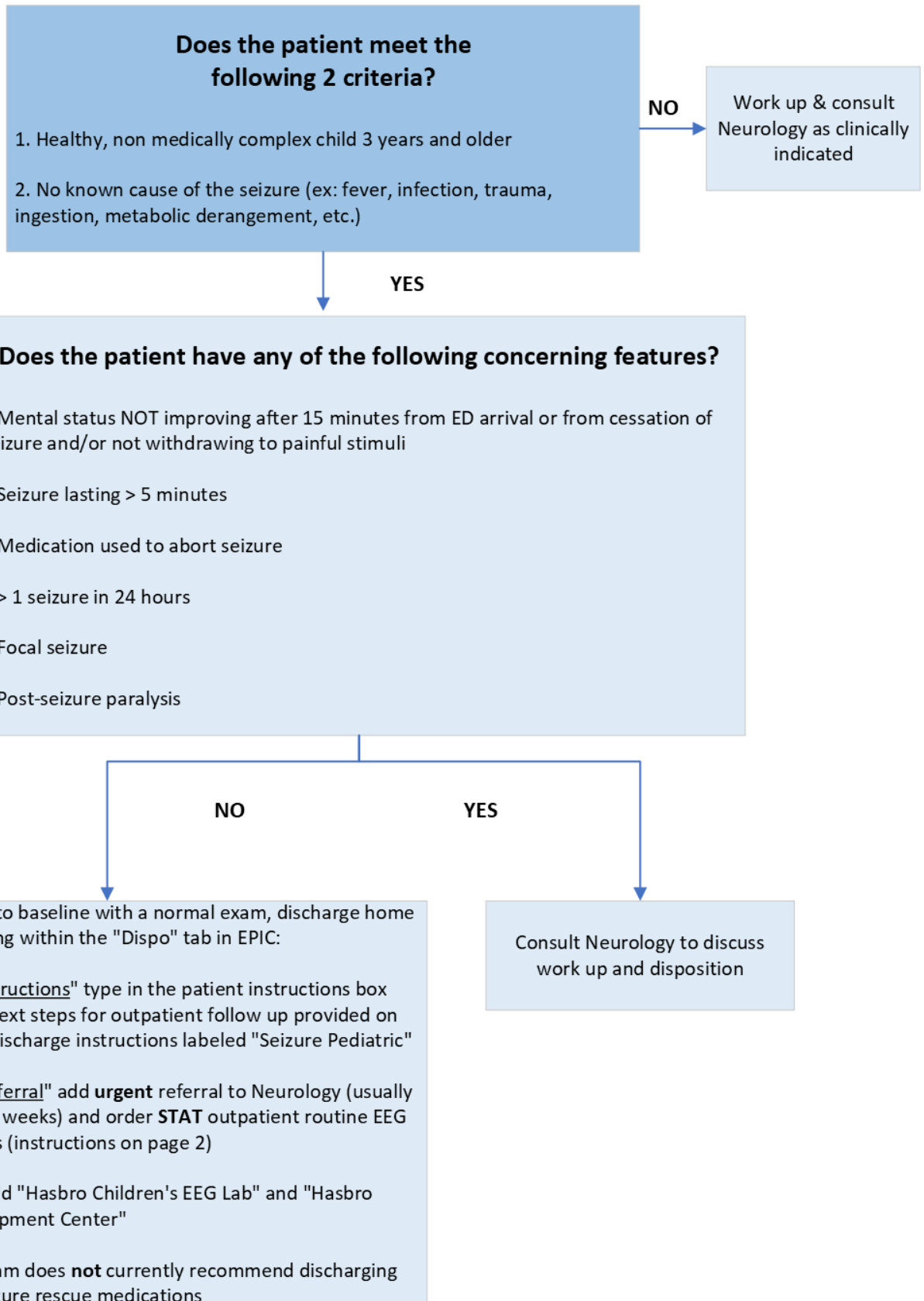

Steps to order "EEG Routine" under dispo tab:

1. Status: Future- Before Next Appt
2. Which location is preferred for the procedure: Rhode Island Hospital
3. Reason for Exam: Seizure- New seizure
3. Patient State: Cooperative
4. Additional Order Details: Priority STAT, **Always CC Results to Ana C Albuja Ponce, MD**

***Dr. Albuja Ponce reviews ALL outpatient routine EEG results, and if abnormal, can expedite next steps**

First Time Unprovoked Seizure Pathway

Include the following discharge instructions:

You were seen in the Emergency Department after having a first lifetime seizure. We need you to do the following:

- Return to the Emergency Department and/or call 911 if a second seizure occurs
- **Call 401-444-7676 to set up an appointment to have an EEG completed.** This is usually done before seeing the Pediatric Neurology team
- **Call 401-444-5685 to set up an appointment to be seen** within 1-3 weeks with the Pediatric Neurology team
